-**Light weight bath towel** (20 x 40 or 52 x 27) in a dark color. No thick towels.

-**2 or 3 bath size bars of soap.** Bars should equal 8 to 9 oz total and be in original wrapping. No travel size bars.

-**Adult toothbrushes** in original packaging.

-**Study comb**

-**Metal nail clippers** (large size, attached file optional)

Please be sure there are no symbols (religious, flag, military, camouflage) on any items.

There will be a box at church to collect these items throughout lent; drop them off at your convenience.

Council Minutes – February 13, 2022

In attendance: Gloria Lopatofsky, Mari Hackbarth, Liz Shinn, Laura Heagle, Joe Cunningham, Lynn Kimbrough, Pastor Bev Piro; Absent: Bud Obert

1. Call to order - Gloria called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.
2. Opening prayer - Pastor Bev led us in an opening prayer.
3. Approval of agenda - Motion to approve the agenda by Lynn with the addition of one new business item, the MSP for St. Andrew, second by Joe, motion carried.
4. Approval of council minutes - Joe moved to approve all minutes with one vote, second by Gloria. Motion carried. Motion to approve minutes from: January 9, January 12, and the January 30 Annual Meeting by Joe, second by Mari, motion carried.
5. Pastor's Report - Pastor Bev submitted her report in writing (below) and will discuss the items as they come up in the agenda.
6. Council President's Report - no report. There was a discussion about Bud's fall since it happened at church, prayers for his full and speedy recovery.
7. Treasurer's report – Mari was unable to provide written reports due to Sammie's sick leave. There was a discussion about covering bills, reports, and payroll during Sammie's absence. With the switch to Realm software we have to pull in beginning balances. Mari offered to keep in touch with Sammie and work with Jill Hartman for assistance. Julie and Joe Cunningham will help get the year-end giving statements mailed out this week. Mari will go by and check the postal mail, Lynn will monitor the church email.
8. Ministry updates (*Council liaison*)
 - a. Worship (*Gloria, Joe, Laura, Liz*) - There was a discussion about masks, we will encourage masks but they will be optional and those not wearing a mask should continue to social distance from others in the sanctuary.

Pastor Bev discussed the Ash Wednesday plan. For Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday, St. Andrew will offer worship at 11 am (not on Zoom) and Advent will offer worship at 7 pm in person and streamed via Facebook Live.

Advent offers Soup Suppers on Wednesdays at 5:45 pm. and in-person Holden Evening Prayer; St. Andrew will offer Holden Evening Prayer via zoom as we did last year. Members from Advent and St. Andrew are welcome to attend either.
 - b. Fellowship/Member care (*Liz, Lynn*) - There will be a Mardi Gras event at Advent Lutheran on Sunday, February 27 at 11:30 a.m. with food and games. We would like to have 15 or more people from St. Andrew attend to begin meeting Advent folks. There is also a robust schedule of upcoming Senior Saints events to which Advent's XYZ group is invited.

The home delivery team will be out with Lent bags prior to Ash Wednesday, look for them on March 2.

c. Faith Formation (*Laura*) - The final C.S. Lewis session hosted by Advent will be February 27, and then Vicar Kaari is doing a class on minor prophets during Lent. Laura is doing a Bible study with a small group at Arbor View.

d. Communication (*Joe, Lynn*) - Joe will update the website with the Senior Saints schedule and Lynn will post the events on Facebook. Joe continues to put the Scroll on the website too.

e. Outreach - Pastor Bev would like to focus on making personal care kits for Lutheran World Relief during Lent. There has been a plea for the kits. The idea will be to collect the items that go into the kits and then Senior Saints can assemble the kits after Easter and ship them.

f. Property maintenance - There was discussion about two new leaks in the roof and how to get on Eric Gunderson's schedule for repairs, and there is a piece of siding missing that needs attention. No one took this for action.

Pastor Bev did ask Tom Hartke to pursue looking into switching our property insurance and he agreed to do the research and make a recommendation.

There is something wrong with one of the furnaces or thermostat in the sanctuary, we need the furnace company to come out to check it. Joe will contact the furnace company and schedule a time with them. Rocky Mountain Trees did some work and left a statement, Mari will review when she goes in.

9. Liaison reports - (liaison)

a. Healing Arts Center (Barb B) – There will be a Sacred Way Healing Fair in April, the Saturday after Easter, April 23.

b. Secrest Elementary (Mary Ann, Jenny) - no report

c. Parish council (liaisons) - The first meeting of the Parish Council was held on February 3. Liz reported the group met and tried to get their arms around the scope of their work and a better understanding of the authority to make decisions. The next Parish Council meeting is Wednesday, February 16.

10. Old business -

a. Synod Assembly - The decision was made to move the Synod Assembly to Loveland. It will now be on May 2, 3, 4 in Loveland rather than El Paso (they are postponing El Paso until next year). Erin was going to attend but the change to a weekday event doesn't work for her schedule. Gloria will go instead.

11. New business -

a. Election of officers - Lynn moved to elect Joe as president, Gloria as vice president, Lynn as secretary, and Mari as treasurer. Second by Joe. Motion carried.

b. Ministry Site Profile for St. Andrew - With the yoking and other coming changes for St.

Andrew, we need to update our Ministry Site Profile. Joe will take the lead on this, Lynn will send the last version to all of council for review. Council members should read through it and to provide Joe any input on changes and updates.

12. Next meeting date – March 13, 2022 following worship at approximately 10:15am.

13. Adjournment - Mari moved to adjourn at 12:02, second by Joe. Motion carried.
